Rep. Rick Brattin Named to House Majority Whip Team

Brattin will serve as House Floor Whip for the 2011 Legislative Session

Jefferson City, MO – Rep. Rick Brattin, R-Harrisonville, will play a key role in helping the House Majority Caucus achieve its legislative priorities for the 2011 session. Brattin was named this week to serve on the Whip Team by Majority Whip, Rep. Jason Smith, R-Salem.
